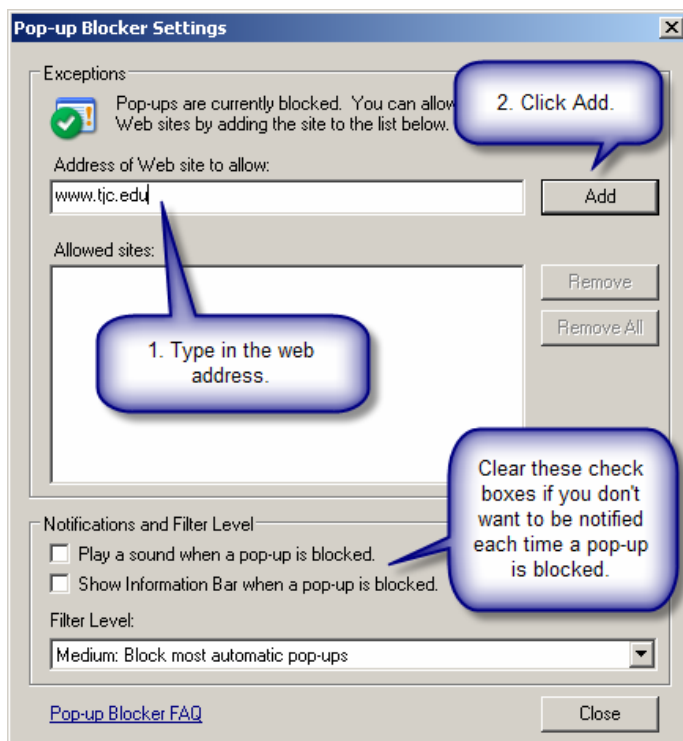
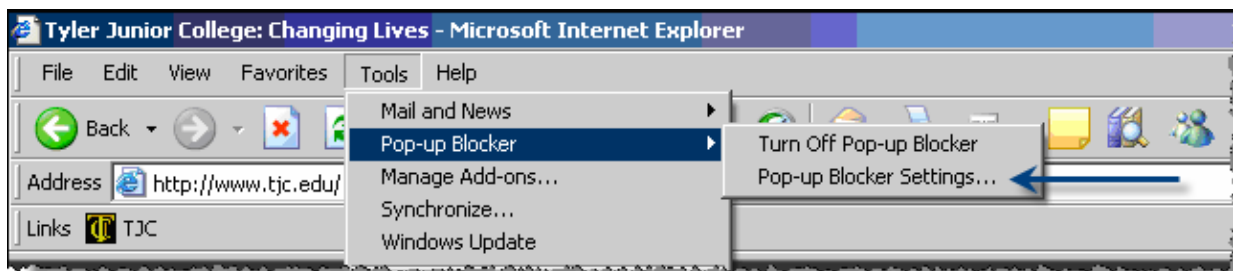
Controlling Your Popup Blocker

Your popup blocker is a filter within Internet Explorer (Firefox has a similar feature) that blocks pop-up windows that bug you with advertisements. By default Internet Explorer has the pop-up blocker enabled for all web sites that you visit.

Some websites, however, must have pop-ups enabled for the website to work effectively. In this case it is a good idea to only enable pop-ups for that particular website. Here's how you do it.

Suppose you want to enable pop-ups for the TJC website at www.tjc.edu.

1. Open Internet Explorer and click on the **Tools** menu option. Move the mouse to Pop-up Blocker and then click on **Pop-up Blocker Settings**.



2. Add the web address of the website and click Add.

If you ever want to **remove** a web site from the list of allowed sites, just click on the site the Allowed sites window and then click **Remove**.
